Crafting the reconciliation bill has been nothing but easy. We appreciate the intense, hard work that every House and Senate Member has put into creating a piece of legislation with the American people in mind. Passing this bill to the President's desk would be a feat of unity and strength among the Republican party. Eagle Forum has supported the process from the beginning, and we will score in favor of final passage.

The most vulnerable will be protected. This bill will defund the abortion industry through the Medicare program. 
